



## Rockwood Water PUD WaterSense Toilet Rebate Program for Duplexes, Triplexes and Fourplexes

### Save Water, Save Money

Property owners and managers can significantly reduce water bills by replacing inefficient toilets (models that use 1.6 gallons or more of water per flush) with a new high-efficiency, 1.28 gallons per flush, WaterSense labeled toilet and may be eligible for a \$50 rebate per toilet.

### Eligibility and Requirements

- Applicants must be a Rockwood Water PUD multi-family residential customer (duplex, triplex and fourplex properties only) with a current water account in good standing.
- Renters or tenants must have written approval from the property owner.
- This program applies to replacement toilets purchased on or after July 1, 2011. New construction is not eligible.
- The purchased/installed toilet must be an approved model. The exact tank and bowl model number of the toilet must be on/match the EPA's WaterSense High Efficiency Toilet (HET) list.
- Each rebate is worth \$50. Limit of 4 toilet rebates per eligible account.
- Old toilet(s) must be recycled. Proof of recycling required.
- Rebates are on a first-come, first-served basis and are subject to the availability of funds.
- Rockwood Water reserves the right to conduct pre and post-inspections to verify eligibility and/or installation.

### How the Rebate Program Works

1. Prior to purchasing new toilets, **contact Rockwood Water PUD at 503-665-4179 to confirm eligible customer status.**
2. **Request toilet rebate application form with reservation number and schedule pre-installation inspection** of your old existing toilet(s).
3. Review list of eligible toilets. **The toilet you purchase must be WaterSense labeled.** For a complete list of approved models, [www.epa.gov/watersense/product\\_search.html](http://www.epa.gov/watersense/product_search.html).
4. **Purchase toilet between the dates of 7/1/11-6/30/12.** Toilets purchased prior to 7/1/11 or later than 6/30/12 will not be eligible for rebates.
5. **Save receipt.** A copy of the dated sales receipt (or invoice) that specifies the toilet brand/model is required\*. The toilet brand/model you purchase must match the eligible model list exactly.

**Note:** Tank and bowl numbers cannot be mixed and matched from different models. Each model has been tested in specific combinations for performance and efficiency.

6. **Recycle old toilet(s) at:**

**\*Request a scale ticket as proof of recycling.\***
  7. **Install new toilet(s).** The new toilet(s) must be installed at the property associated with your Rockwood Water PUD account. Random inspections may occur.
  8. **Complete and sign WaterSense Toilet Rebate Application Form.**
  9. **Submit the following (must be received by Rockwood Water PUD within 45 days of requesting application and reservation number:**
    - WaterSense Toilet Rebate Form (completed and signed)
    - Toilet Sales Receipt or Invoice (original or a copy)
    - Scale Ticket from ECR (original or a copy)

10. **Receive rebate check.** Approximately 4-6 weeks after receiving your completed application and verifying eligibility, Rockwood Water PUD will send a rebate check to the customer of record at the mailing address noted in the account unless requested otherwise.

WaterSense Toilet Rebate Forms and/or documents received after the submission deadline will not be processed. Rockwood Water PUD is not responsible for items lost or delayed in the mail.
