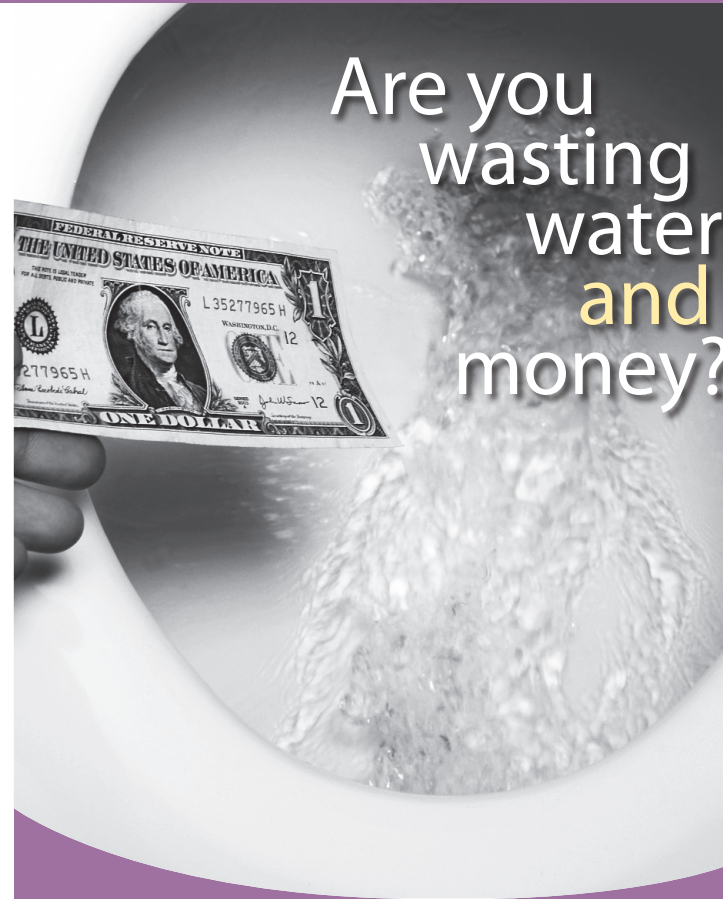

Save Water, Save Money

A High-Efficiency Toilet can save you water and money. For example, replacing a 3.5 gpf toilet with a 1.28 gpf WaterSense® toilet could save as much as 4,000* gallons per person per year. For a family of 4, that could add up to nearly \$175** in savings each year.

Here are two great reasons to purchase your HET right now:

Selecting the right toilet is easy, thanks to WaterSense® – a program sponsored by the Environmental Protection Agency. The WaterSense® label is used on toilets that are certified by independent laboratory testing to meet rigorous criteria for both performance and efficiency. Only HETs that complete the certification process earn the WaterSense label.

Effective July 1, 2009, Rockwood Water PUD will be offering single-family residential customers a \$100 rebate when they replace a toilet that uses 1.6 gallons per flush (gpf) or more with a new WaterSense®-labeled toilet.

* Based on the national estimate of 5 flushes per person per day.

** Reflects water and sewer savings based on 7/1/09 rate of \$8.13 per Ccf (\$6.50 for sewer + \$1.63 for water). Sewer rate per City of Portland. 1 Ccf = 748 gallons.

WaterSense® Toilet Rebate Program Eligibility and Requirements

You must be a Rockwood Water PUD single-family residential customer which owns its own site. You must receive water from Rockwood Water PUD, and your account must be active and in good standing.

Each rebate is worth \$100. Limit of 2 toilet rebates per eligible account

Rebates are available on a first-come, first-served basis. The program will end when funds are depleted or no later than June 30, 2010.

Checklist:

- Review list of eligible toilets.** The toilet you purchase must be WaterSense labeled. For a complete list of approved models, visit: www.epa.gov/watersense.
- Purchase toilet between the dates of 7/1/09-6/30/10.** Toilets purchased prior to 7/1/09 or later than 6/30/10 will not be eligible for rebates.
- Save receipt.** A copy of the dated sales receipt (or invoice) that specifies the toilet brand/model is required*. The toilet brand/model you purchase must match the eligible model list exactly.

Note: Tank and bowl numbers cannot be mixed and matched from different models. Each model has been tested in specific combinations for performance and efficiency.
- Recycle old toilet at:**

- Install new toilet.** The new toilet must be installed at the property associated with your Rockwood Water PUD account. Random inspections may occur.

- Complete and sign WaterSense Toilet Rebate Form.**
- Submit the following (must be received by Rockwood Water PUD no later than July 7, 2010):**
 1. WaterSense Toilet Rebate Form (completed and signed)
 2. Toilet Sales Receipt or Invoice (original or a copy)
 3. Scale Ticket from ECR (original or a copy)

- Receive rebate check.** Approximately 4-6 weeks after receiving your completed application and verifying eligibility, Rockwood Water PUD will send a rebate check to the customer of record at the mailing address noted in the account.

Note: WaterSense Toilet Rebate Forms that are incomplete, lacking required documents, or missing a signature will be returned. WaterSense Toilet Rebate Forms and/or documents received after July 7, 2010, will not be processed. Rockwood Water PUD is not responsible for items lost or delayed in the mail.
